

Maine Mathematics Coaching Project Sponsored by the Office of Graduate Studies

Application and Assurances Instructions

Limited Spaces Available Preferable deadline April 15, 2018

The Maine Mathematics Coaching Project (MMCP) requires a 2 year commitment on behalf of the coaching candidate and the district.

Coaching Candidates must have:

- A Maine Teaching Certificate for B-5 Early Childhood 081, Grades K-3 029, K-8 020; or 7-12 Mathematics 300; and
- A minimum of three (3) years of teaching experience at the PreK-8 grade level.

Recommendation: Coaching Candidate has a Master's degree or is matriculated into a Master's program.

1. Instructions to Coaching Candidate:

Complete all seven (7) parts of the 2-page Application.

Submit a current resume. *Please emphasize your mathematics training and experience.

Submit copies of transcripts from undergraduate and graduate institutions.

Submit a current copy of your Maine teacher certification.

Submit an essay describing your leadership experiences (See Part 5 of Application).

Submit an essay describing your philosophy of mathematics education (See Part 6 of Application).

Submit the completed Application and with all of the above materials and the Assurance from the Superintendent's Office to the Office of Graduate Studies (see address below).

2. Instructions to Administrator:

Complete all three (3) sections of the 3-page Assurances.

Read Section III of the Assurances carefully and obtain the appropriate signatures (Superintendent Principal, and Curriculum Coordinator)

Submit the completed Assurances form and all of the Application materials listed above to:
