



# Shakers

## *Paper Plate Shaker*



Total Cost for materials in picture: \$0.71

### *Materials:*

- ❖ Two Paper plates (any size)
- ❖ Shaker Filling (bottle caps, plastic pieces, beads, nut shells, etc.)
- ❖ Pipe Cleaners
- ❖ Sticky Back Vinyl
- ❖ Materials for decoration
- ❖ Hole punch

### *Try this:*

Step 1- Cut pipe cleaners into two inch sections.

Step 2- Place paper plates together, with flat rims touching and bottoms facing outward.

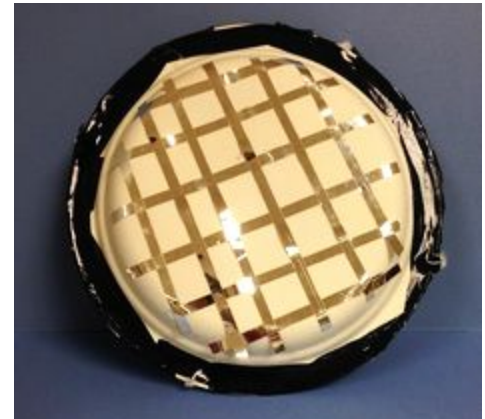
Step 3- Punch holes around the rim every few inches. Make sure the holes on both plates line up!

Step 4- Use pipe cleaners to poke through the holes and fasten them together. Leave one set of holes empty!

Step 5- Pour your filling into the the shaker & use a pipe cleaner piece to tie the final holes.

Step 6- Use sticky back Vinyl to seal the edges

Step 7- Decorate!





There are a variety of different materials you can use for all parts of this project!  
Tons of different materials to fill the shaker with, and even more to decorate it with.

## ***Shakers for small hands!***

**Materials:** (For a set of 2)

- Two green or white plastic take apart containers and two clear ones (\$.05 each)
- Bag of beads (\$.20)
- Roll of sticky back vinyl (\$.20)



**Try This:**

- 1) Place half a bag of beads into each of the green containers
- 2) Place clear cap on top and tape shut with sticky back
- 3) Decoate!
